Cynthia Bringle & Ben Owen III

Jeffcoat Pottery is pleased to offer their winter workshop with potters Cynthia Bringle and Ben Owen III. During this special workshop, both will be discussing the elements of good form and design in making pottery. Cynthia and Ben will demonstrate a variety of functional and decorative forms, including altering and creating texture on the surface of the clay. Glazes and other finishing techniques will be discussed for different firing applications in wood, gas, and electric kilns. As time allows, marketing will be discussed.



Cynthia Bringle was born in 1939 in Memphis, Tenn. She studied painting and pottery at the Memphis Academy of Art, where she earned her bachelor of fine arts. She received her master of fine arts from Alfred University in New York, and today lives in Penland, NC, where she teaches once every 2 - 3 years at the prestigious Penland School of Crafts, and has also taught at Haystack and Arrowmont. Her studio, Bringle Pottery, is nearby. She is a fellow of the American Craft Council and was awarded life membership in the Southern Highland Craft

Guild. Cynthia has also been awarded a prestigious Honorary Doctorate from the Memphis College of Art. Cynthia's best company is Margie, her beloved dog.



Ben Owen III (b. 1968) has made pottery since he was 8 years old at the site where his grandfather and father established the Old Plank Road Pottery in the Seagrove area of Piedmont North Carolina in 1959. Ben III worked at the potter's wheel during high school and in the late 1980's while in college at Pfeiffer University and later at East Carolina University. He continues to work in the shapes, glazes, and traditions of his grandfather and has traveled in the US and abroad to Japan, Australia, New Zealand, Europe, and China where he has diversified his influences in clay. Ben III lives with his wife and three children in the community Westmoore, near Seagrove, NC.

Both Cynthia and Ben's work are part of various private and public collections throughout the world and both have recently been named North Carolina Living Treasures.
